ANNUAL FRESH PIE SALE

We are selling freshly made **Apple & Blueberry** Pies this year!

- Who: Sparta Band & Choir Students 6th - 12th grade
- What: A great way to earn money for the music programs at Sparta Middle School & High School! This fundraiser goes 50% toward our general fund, and 50% toward the Music Booster Scholarship Fund, which all students are eligible to use.
- Selling Points: Emphasize that the pies are made with local fruit, are made fresh, and are DELICIOUS!
- Delivering Tips: Plan on delivering your pies on the day that they are made (November 13) or make sure you have room in your freezer. The pies are made fresh and cannot sit out for a long time. They can be stored in the refrigerator for 2 days or should be put into the freezer the same day as pickup.
- Helpers: The pie making is at the Casnovia Old School Community Center (142 S. Main St. Casnovia, MI). **We need MANY student and parent workers** (there are machines that you need to be at least 18 years old to use).
 - Friday, November 12 from 5:30pm - 8:30pm. The helpers will staple boxes and prep the baking of the pies. There is also a lot of heavy lifting to be done.
 - Saturday, November 13 - 7:30am – 1:00pm (pie assembling crew) & 12:00pm – 3:00pm ish (clean up crew). At least half of the crew must be adults 18 or older. We need lots of help!
