4:00 AM: Two 56 passenger motorcoaches (maximum seats available to group are 111) arrive at Sparta High School, 480 S. State St., Sparta, MI 49345 (616-887-8213) for loading

* **All passengers must be equipped with proper identification; The Department of Homeland Security requires that most U.S. citizens and foreign nationals need to present a PASSPORT OR PASSPORT CARD (Passport Card not valid for air travel) to cross the US border. *EXCEPTIONS* - For those under 16, you may instead present a certified birth certificate and picture I.D. Also groups of U.S. citizen children ages 16 through 18, when traveling with a school or religious group, social organization, or sports team, will be able to enter under adult supervision with originals or copies of their birth certificates or other proof of citizenship. Group must also be prepared to present a letter on organizational letterhead with the following information: The name of the group and supervising adult, a list of the children on the trip (including their the primary address, phone number, date of birth, place of birth, and name of at least one parent or legal guardian for each child), and a written and signed statement of the supervising adult certifying that he or she has obtained parental or legal guardian consent for each participating child. Non US citizens may be required to have a VISA. *Without proper identification, border authorities may not allow you to cross the border.***
